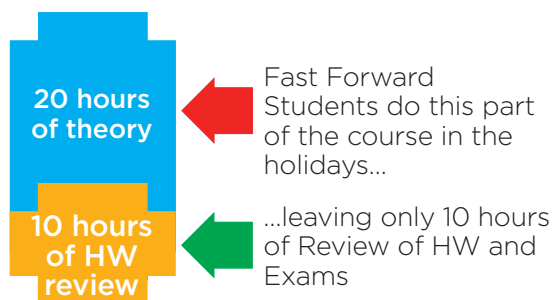

➔ What is the Talent 100 Fast Forward Program?

The Fast Forward program is a program that allows students to do the bulk of their learning in the holidays. The aim of the Fast Forward course is to allow capable students to accelerate their learning, so they have greater time flexibility in the term.

In a typical Talent 100 Seminar, instructors will spend 2.5 hours going through the theory and 30 minutes on the homework. At the end of each module, students take an examination and review that total about 6 hours during the term. Hence, a typical ten week term is comprised of about 20 hours of theory, and 10 hours of examination, and homework review:



Fast Forward students will study the theory booklets of the course in the holidays preceding term. Our Fast Forward Programs are held at 10am to 3.30pm, with a half hour break for lunch. Students who attend the Fast Forward course will then attend a dedicated 'Review Class' (30 mins) each week during term to review the homework, and must also attend the Exam & Review Lessons.

➔ What are the benefits of the Fast Forward Program?

The main benefits of the FF program are:

Flexibility and Time Management. A major benefit of the FF program is that it frees up a student's time during the term. By investing time in the holidays to study the course, the student reduces their weekly time commitment during the term.

This is a particular advantage for students: in Year 12 who must often 'drop everything' to study for assessments that directly count towards their HSC; who are doing two or three subjects at Talent 100; and students who have extra curricular activities during the school term.

Efficient and structured learning in the holidays.

The Fast Forward program also helps students to utilise their free time in the holidays effectively and in a structured and enjoyable learning environment.

Getting ahead in class. Finally, the Fast Forward Program allows student to learn ahead of class, and gain a competitive advantage on their peers. Because we cover ALL syllabus dot points to a FULL MARKS standard, students who attend the Fast Forward program will have covered the entire term's worth of work before their first day at school. This means they will have a greater understanding of what the teacher is talking about and be familiar with how to do the typical questions. This second-time advantage is important, because when a student is covering the material for the second time, they will find it much easier to score the top marks. Many of our successful students have done the Fast Forward programs, and often remark that they can correct subtle errors that their teachers have made.

➔ Who should do the Fast Forward Program?

The FF Program is for any student who is:

- + doing three subjects at Talent 100, as it will reduce their weekly commitment from 9 hours (which can be excessive when school is busy) to about 4 hours.
- + prepared and motivated to invest their time in the holidays in order to advance their learning.
- + Students in Year 11 who have completed the Headstart course, and Students in year 12 who have completed the introduction course

In contrast, students who feel they will 'forget' the information, may benefit more from doing the class on a regular, weekly basis. If this is the case, such students should not do the Fast Forward Program.

➔ What subjects does Talent 100 offer Fast Forward for?

For **year 11 students**, Fast Forward is offered for Physics and Chemistry

For **year 12 students**, Fast Forward is offered for Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics Ext 1. We do not offer Fast Forward for Mathematics Ext 2, as we believe the difficulty of the course makes it impossible to learn properly in such a condensed period of time.

➔ What does Fast Forward cost? Can I do the fast forward course, if I am not enrolled in the yearly program?

The Fast Forward course is identical to the regular Yearly Program, except that students do most of their work in the holidays. Because the materials, teachers, and timings are the same, the cost is the same as the regular course.

Fast Forward is not a separate course to the yearly program; it is merely an option of studying the majority of the yearly program in the holidays.

➔ When do I have to hand in my homework?

To ensure that the homework is marked in time, Fast Forward students must hand in their homework one week before the homework is due in the termly course.

➔ Can I attend some lessons in the term, and some during the Fast Forward holiday courses?

Students may NOT elect to do part of their program in the Holidays and part in the term, as they are effectively occupying two places. Our courses are designed for a maximum of 13 students, and so this could prevent another student from attending the course.

If circumstances are exceptional, we may allow you to part of your course during the holidays and part during the term. Each case will be considered on its individual merits by the Centre Manager.

➔ If I attend Fast Forward, may I come to regular lessons during the term to revise?

If students require extra revision, we recommend that they attend an Interactive Tutorial as it will be more time effective for their studies

Notwithstanding, in exceptional circumstances, we may allow students to come to regular lessons during the term to revise. If you would like to come to regular lessons, you must submit your application to the Centre Manager at least one week before that lesson commences. Fast Forward students are required to bring the notes that were printed form them; no notes will be reprinted.

➔ What are the dates and times for the Fast Forward Program?

The Fast Forward Program is held in every school holidays.
